

SKIING AND SNOWBOARDING PROGRAM INFORMATION

1. Attach the lift ticket/pass to your coat. You must have this ticket/pass for a lesson and to ride the lifts. If you change jacket at any time please remove your ticket/pass and place it on another jacket or if you need to wear a jacket please remove your ticket/pass. If a student needs a replacement ticket there will be a \$10.00 dollar fee. Everyone taking a lesson has been given a class number and time. PLEASE MAKE A NOTE OF YOUR NUMBER AND CLASS TIME.
2. Take your equipment to the front of the lodge. Leave your snowboard, skis and poles in the racks provided. DO NOT bring equipment into the lodge.
3. Ski or Boards must be put in racks when not in use!!!!!!!
4. Put your boots on inside the lodge. There are shelves and lockers to store your shoes and other belongings.
5. If you have used a chair lift, t-bar or rope tow before, you may now go skiing or snowboarding. If this is your first time skiing or snowboarding, do not attempt to use the lifts. You may injure yourself and others.
6. When your class time is announced, go to the lesson meeting place and stand next to the sign with your class number on it.
7. After the lesson, you may ski or board until your departure is announced.
8. If you have any question or problems, go to the information desk in the lodge. Area representatives and monitors will be here to assist you.

SKIER/SNOWBOARD RESPONSIBILITY CODE

There are elements of risk in skiing and snowboarding that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce.

Ski or board under control and in such a manner that you can stop or avoid the person below you.

When going downhill, or overtaking another person, you must avoid the person below you.

Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.

When entering a trail or starting downhill, yield to others.

All skiers and snowboarders must wear retention straps or other devices to prevent runaway skis or boards.

Keep off closed trails, closed areas and observe all posted signs.

This is a partial list. Be safety conscious.

RENTAL INSTRUCTION

1. Before going to the rental shop, place all of your belongings in the racks provided in the lodge. You'll Need both hands to carry equipment so do not bring anything into the rental shop.
2. See your monitor for your rental form.. Go to the door with the large ENTER sign at the rental shop. When you go in , proceed to the boot station in and orderly fashion.
3. Helmet sizing- If you are renting a helmet , you will be sized outside in front of the RENTAL SHOP.
4. The boot attendant will give you boots and show you how they work and how to carry them. Proceed to The ski or snowboard bench to get your equipment. Give the attendant your rental form.
5. The attendant will give you your skis or snowboard, show you how to operate the bindings and how to Carry them. Listen carefully, you will receive poles as you exit.
6. Go to the front of the lodge and put the skis or snowboard and poles in the racks provided. Remember The number on your skis or board and where you put them . Do not bring any equipment other than Your helmet and boots in the lodge.
7. Take the boots inside the lodge and put them on. Be sure the ski boots are buckled properly. If there Is a problem with the fit take them back to the rental shop through the last door on the right marked RETURNS.
8. Take the snowboard, skis and poles to the lesson meeting place. Get into the bindings as you were Instructed by the rental shop attendant. Make sure there is no snow on the bottom of your boot.
9. SKIS OR BOARDS MUST BE PUT IN RACKS WHEN NOT IN USE !!!!!!!!!
10. Skiers and snowboarders are responsible for the cost of boards or skis, boot, poles and helmets Assigned to them, if they are lost or stolen. When your departure announcement is made, all rentals Skis, boards, poles boots must be returned to the rental shop. Go through the door marked returns. DO NOT LEAVE RENTALS OUTSIDE. If renting a HELMET YOU TAKE IT WITH YOU!!!!

*** FAILURE TO RETURN RENTAL EQUIPMENT INTO THE RENTAL BUILDING WILL RESULT IN AND \$8.00 CHARGE, (per occurrence), which must be paid prior to the next week's program.
